

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Communication Enterprise strives to provide quality print and electronic communications for the people on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation. KMHA is chartered as a public radio station, therefore, is obligated to sustain itself through support of it's members and funding organizations and


WHEREAS, the Fort Berthold Communication Enterprise has expanded and improved the communications for the Tribe by publishing a newspaper, the MANDAN, HIDATSA AND ARICKARA TIMES. The newspaper can sustain itself, as other newspapers by selling ads and printing and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Fort Berthold Communication Enterprise Board of Directors is requesting that the Fort Berthold Tribal Business Council strongly encourage through letters and/or resolution that tribal departments, tribal organizations, organizations that do business for and with the tribe, the Indian Health Clinic, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs support the efforts of the Fort Berthold Communications Enterprise, Inc by contracting with the MHA Times for printing of envelopes, letterhead, brochures, booklets and other printing needs. Also, that these organizations purchase ads in the newspaper and on radio station so that this tribal enterprise can continue to provide print and electronic communications for the Tribe.
