

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE
THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES
OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Indian Acute Distress Donation Program (IADDP) was previously approved for the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, One of the primary purposes of the IADDP is to conserve the range resources of Indian reservations; and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has not complied with the Tribal Business Council's directive to develop a drought contingency plan for the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, An extension of the IADDP until July 15th would provide a mechanism for range resources to at least partially recover from the severe drought conditions experienced in 1988.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby requests an extension of the IADDP until July 15, 1989, and directs the Secretary of the Interior to work with the Secretary of Agriculture to obtain that extension.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
