

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE
THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES
OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) is the major agricultural lender to Tribal members on Fort Berthold; and

WHEREAS, Many FmHA clients are ill prepared when they obtain loans from FmHA; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council believe that a training program would help current and potential FmHA clients be better agricultural operators.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby requests that the FmHA work with the Three Affiliated Tribes, Bureau of Indian Affairs, and Extension Service to develop a training program for agricultural operators on Fort Berthold.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby requests that the FmHA review its interpretation of the Agricultural Credit Act of 1987 to determine if delinquent clients returning incomplete responses to the Notice of Acceleration are eligible for Primary Loan Servicing.
