

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS,** The Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council has reviewed the invoices for services rendered by the law firm of Hobbs, Strauss, Dean & Wilder for the months of September, 1986 thru February, 1989 in the total amount of \$ 11,358.24.
- WHEREAS,** The Three Affiliated Tribes' has already issued a check in the amount of \$ 7,350.00 on December 20, 1988 as a payment against this outstanding balance with the understanding that this resolution would be prepared and submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for approval; and
- WHEREAS,** The Three Affiliated Tribes' do not accept the charges for those costs labelled as item D. for a total of \$ 185.68 on the February 27, 1989 invoice because all costs being invoiced this period were on fixed ceiling budgets.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council hereby approves, and requests the Secretary of the Department of Interior to accept, the invoices attached for services rendered by the law firm of Hobbs, Strauss, Dean & Wilder for the months of September, 1986 thru February, 1989 in the total amount of \$ 11,358.24 (Invoices attached).
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Three Affiliated Tribes' shall issue a check in the amount of \$ 4,008.24 to the law firm of Hobbs, Strauss, Dean & Wilder upon approval of this resolution from the Secretary of the Department of Interior.





A. Yakima Case Amicus Brief -- \$0

We spent 5.8 more hours on this, but there is no
further charge as our budget was \$4,000, which we billed and
you paid.

B. Reburial Project -- \$3,000

Our agreed budget for this project was \$3,000,
which we are hereby billing. There will be no further
charges on the Reburial Project, though there will
necessarily be a little more time finishing it up.

C. 638 Project -- \$1,000

We spent considerable time on the 638 Amendments
for eight clients, including Fort Berthold. Fort Berthold's
allocated one-eighth share for January and December was 13.4
hours (mostly Bobo Dean). At the contract rate this comes

D. Expenses -- \$185.68


