RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- whereas, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes

 generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business

 Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in

 the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes

 and of the enrolled members thereof; and
 - WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council believes that Docket funds designated for land purchases must be used in a manner that protects the Tribes and serves the best interest of all tribal members.
 - WHEREAS, The Tribes have a necessary need to own and control land around existing and proposed public use recreation areas; and
 - WHEREAS, The Tribes are unable to purchase this type of land with FmHA loan funds because the tracts do not "cash flow".
 - NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the use of funds from investments which matured on November 17, 1988, which are generally referred to as Hospitable Funds to purchase the types of land described above.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution amends Tribal Resolution No. 88-250-TL by adding the following to the end of section 2 of the "and land adjacent to existing or proposed public use recreation areas on Lake Sakakawea."
