RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes realizes the need for adolescent and adult education in the prevention of AIDS, and without immediate intervention our people will be at risk; and
- WHEREAS, Their is a need for a community infrastructure that will be the neucleus in the development of an initial short-term and then a medium-term AIDS prevention plan that will provide leaders with intensive education in the promotion of both behavorial change at the individual level and community development at the societal level; and
- WHEREAS, The University of North Dakota is proposing an intensive threeyear project to initiate community preventive activities among rural Native Americans and develop the infrastructure necessary for long-term prevention; and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribes supports the University of North Dakota's project and directs the Human Resources Department to work with the planning, development, and implementation at the local level; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribes supports the appointment of an AIDS Task Force of the Human Resources Department as the local community infrastructure that will provide the leadership in the prevention of AIDS on the Fort Berthold Reservation.
