RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the autority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (d) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to negotiate with the federal, state, and local governments on behalf of the Tribes, and to advise and consult with representatives of the Interior Department on all activities of the Department that may affect the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Greywater v. Joshua decision in the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals created the need for the Bureau of Indian Affairs to establish a Court of Indian Offenses under the provisions of 25 CFR Part 11; and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs needs to appoint CFR judges in the interimand needs Tribal Business Council confirmation of these appointments; and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs wishes to appoint Clarinda B. Young Bird to the position of Magistrate.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the above appointment is determined to be necessary and the Tribal Council by this action confirms this appointment.
