RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes' Gambling Commission, pursuant to congestion mitigation has recommended that an age limit be set to obviate the problem of congestion and unsupervised juveniles at gaming operations; and
- WHEREAS, By the authority, of Section 2.6(d) of the Gambling Ordinance of Chapter 27 of the Three Affiliated Tribes Code of Laws, to promulgate regulations subject to the approval of the Tribal Business Council, the Gambling Commission has proposed a rule providing that attendance at Tribally approved gaming operations be limited to the age of 16 years and above;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council pursuant to its considered judgement and the Tribal gambling Ordinance hereby, concur with the Gambling Commission's recommendation, and approve the regulation which limits attendance at Tribally approved gaming operations to persons at the age of 16 years and above.
