- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI Section 5(j) empowers the Tribes to protect and preserve the natural resources of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council desires to do all things possible to promote activities on the Fort Berthold Reservation which provide recreational opportunities for members of the Three Affiliated Tribes and others; and
- WHEREAS, A great deal of interest has been expressed in developing the (legal description) as a recreation area; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council believes that such an area would make a good recreation area; and
- WHEREAS, The area has been withdrawn from the adjacent range unit.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby designates the \$1/2\$1/2\$W1/4 of Section 31, Township 148 North, Range 92 West, as the Moccasin Creek Recreation Area and hereby submits a lease proposal to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby approves a perpetual public access right-of-way to the Three Affiliated Tribes across lands owned by the Three Affiliated Tribes in allotment numbers 1075A and T2010 and waives compensation for the right-of-way.
