## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The health of all people is one true measure of a Tribe, a nation or state/county/city; and
- WHEREAS, The health of Native Americans and Americans is inseparably linked with the health of peoples throughout the world; and
- WHEREAS, All nations of the world, acting through the World Health Organization, of which the United States is an active member, are pledged to the goal of Health for All by the year 2000; and
- WHEREAS, April 7 of each year has been established by the World Health Organization as World Health Day an occasion to educate and to inform, to encourage increased community involvement, to focus on the unity of our health concerns; and
- WHEREAS, The 1990 World Health Day theme, "Our Planet, Our Health; Think Globally, Act Locally", stresses the importance of community participation in promoting a safe and clean environment; one of the many pre-requisites for leading a healthy lifestyle.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby declare April, 1990 as World Health month and urge all Tribal members and all residents of the Fort Berthold Reservation to take part in observance and activities designed to advance the cause of "Health for All" by promoting awareness and by encouraging participation in the worldwide efforts of attaining a healthy and safe environment.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in an effort to organize and promote activities relating to Human, Education, Health and Environmental issues, the following Tribal and IHS employees have accepted responsibility to coordinate activities during World Health Month as follows:
