RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE

FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Indian Acute Distress Donation program was established by Executive Order No. 11336 in order to assist members of Indian tribes who graze cattle on reservation lands that have been adversely affected by droughts or other natural catastrophes; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Indian Reservation is suffering from a chronic drought which has damaged the Reservation grazing lands; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Indian Reservation remains an acute distress area because of chronic unemployment and conditions caused by the long term drought; and
- WHEREAS, The timely provision of grain owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation could relieve grazing pressure on grazing lands which have been damaged by the drought; and
- WHEREAS, The timely provision of Commodity Credit Corporation could be accomplished by extending the duration of the Indian Acute Distress Donation Program.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby reaffirms the designation of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation as an Acute Distress Area and requests the Secretary of Agriculture to work with the Secretary of Interior to extend the Indian Acute Distress Donation Program to May 30, 1991.
