- WHEREAS, In Chapter 27, Section 2, Subsection 2.1 and 2.4 discusses the composition and selection of Gaming Commission members; and
- WHEREAS, Due to changes in administration, resignation, etc. there are vacancies on the Three Affiliated Tribes Gaming Commission; and
- WHEREAS, To be prepared for further gaming development on the Fort Berthold Reservation and to ensure proper supervision of existing gaming activity the Three Affiliated Tribes Gaming Commission needs to be returned to full membership.
