RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The residents of the Fort Berthold Reservation and the members of the Three Affiliated Tribes depend upon the Fort Berthold Community College for their educational and vocational training needs; and
- WHEREAS, The existing space rented by the Fort Berthold Community College from area high schools and other entities is not sufficient for the provision of vocational education instruction and its associated student support services; and
- WHEREAS, The US Department of Education has funding available for such activities under the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Program No. 84.101; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Community College has prepared an Application For Financial Assistance for a new vocational facility and student support services,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby supports the Fort Berthold Community College's execution and submittal of the referenced Application under CFDA 84.101 to the US Department of Education.

Natural Resources Department to submit a bid to have their Solid Waste Program collect Minot Air Base refuse, with an amendment to have the Tribal Chairman research, execute and submit a bid, seconded by Titus Hall. Vote: Six (6) in favor, motion carried. Resolution No. 91-122-JJR

ITEM 6 FORT BERTHOLD COMMUNITY COLLEGE:

Chairman Wilkinson entertained a motion to have a closed session at this time because of the sensitivity of the issue relative to the loan being requested. Moved by Titus Hall, seconded by Secretary Rabbithead. Vote: Four (4) in favor, one (1) opposed, one (1) not voting, motion carried.

After discussion, Lynn Dockter-Pinnick reported that their (FBCC) attorney is investigating their ability to prosecute the former employee through their bonding insurance.

Treasurer Bird Bear moved for approval to authorize the Fort Berthold Community College Board of Directors to secure a loan in the amount of \$420,000 plus interest from the First International Bank of Watford City, ND, secured by the Tribal Trust/Lease income with repayment from the 1992 Tribal Docket 350-G Higher Education amount, with amendment plus interest for seven (7) years and using \$60,000 each year of Docket money. Seconded by Secretary Rabbithead. Vote: Six (6) in favor, motion carried. Resolution No. 91-123-JJR

The Council members requested the list of figures given during the presentation by Lyn Dockter-Pinnick.

Titus Hall moved for approval of resolution to authorize the Fort Berthold Community College's execution and submittal of application for financial assistance for a new vocational facility and student support services under the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Program No. 84.101 in the amount of approximately \$700,000 for a three-year period, seconded by Treasurer Bird Bear. Vote: Six (6) in favor, motion carried. Resolution No. 91-124-JJR

ITEM 7 NATURAL RESOURCES DEPARTMENT'S ENVIRONMENTAL DIVISION:

Treasurer Bird Bear moved for approval of resolution for the execution and submittal of the Natural Resources Department's Environmental Division's application for the FY 1991 Recontracting of the P.O. 93-638 Contract "CTA00336290 in the amount of \$167,400 for the study of Fort Berthold Reservation's Hydrologic/Cycle by the U.S. Geological Survey. Seconded by Secretary Rabbithead. Vote: Six (6) in favor, motion carried. Resolution No. 91-125-JJR
