

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council wishes to promote education opportunities for all Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Head Start Program has more potentially eligible student clients than it has space for, especially in the Parshall Service area; and

WHEREAS, The Head Start Program has secured additional funding from the Office of Human Development Services - Administration for Children Youth and Family (OHDS-ACYF) for expansion of services; and

WHEREAS, The Head Start Program has inspected and wishes to acquire a used Three Bedroom Double Wide Suburban Home trailer in Parshall, ND,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby authorizes the purchase of a used Three Bedroom Double Wide Suburban Home trailer in Parshall, ND for the price of \$17,500.00.
