RESOLUTION
OF THE
GOVERNING BODY
OF THE
THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES
OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes' traditional belief that land is very sacred and is the center of tribal existence, and;

WHEREAS, The General Services Administration has determined that there is excess lands, which the Corp of Engineers administer, are located around Lake Sakakawea be returned to the Three Affiliated Tribes; and

WHEREAS, Bureau of Indian Affairs has been contacted and instructed on how the tribe can obtain these excess lands; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the Bureau of Indian Affairs to do all things necessary to obtain these excess lands from the General Services Administration and return these properties into trust on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
