## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The members of the Tribal Business Council must travel to various cities to conduct business on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes, and a credit card is essential for travel for reserving rooms, vehicles, etc.; and
- WHEREAS, The First International Bank of Watford City, North Dakota will issue Mastercard Corporate credit cards to the Three Affiliated Tribes upon receipt of a Tribal Business Council Resolution authorizing the application and specifying financial responsibility,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes the application for and acquisition of said credit cards,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribes assumes financial responsibility for all obligations to the cards.

## CERTIFICATION
