**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and,

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled tribal members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Central North American Trade Corridor Association has been created by a local organizing committee to act as a catalyst in promotion, development and establishment of a north/south trade corridor along U. S Highway 83 from Canada to Mexico, and

WHEREAS, The Central North American Trade Corridor Association will strive to facilitate trade and enhance transportation along the route, and

WHEREAS, The Central North American Trade Corridor has the potential to develop into the world's largest trading bloc, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council, New Town North Dakota, that it does hereby endorse the Central North American Trade Corridor Association, and further that it encourages the development of the Central North American Trade Corridor with its potential for stimulating the economy.
