 interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and
 of the enrolled tribal members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 3, of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes grants to the Tribal Business Council all necessary Soverign Authority, both legislative and Judicial, for the purposes of excercising the jurisdiction granted by the people in Article I of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Governing Body of the Three Affiliated Tribes that through the Federal Register that Tribes have the opportunity to participate in Integration Employment, training and related services provided by Indian Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Governing Body of the Three Affiliated Tribes has determined that it is in the best interest of the Three Affiliated Tribes and its' membership to participate in this project; and
- WHEREAS, The Governing Body has determined that actions must be taken to reduce joblessness and serve tribally determined goals; and
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the tribe authorizes and approves of this tribes' participation in the above-described demonstration project.
