- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes are currently faced with escalating costs to landfill solid wastes; one way to defray these costs is to provide a recycling, reuse, and reduction program in the form of a cultural curriculum, provided by the Tribal Education Department;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes
  Tribal Business Council hereby grants approval for the
  Three Affiliated Tribes Natural Resource Department to
  submit a grant application to the Environmental
  Protection Agency for funding to provide a cultural
  environmental curriculum and a coordinator for the
  program;
