# RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- RESOLUTION ENTITLED: "RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND GRANT A TRIBAL DAY-CARE LICENSE"
- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- whereas, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and the residents on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 3 of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to exercise all sovereign authority, both legislative and judicial, within the scope of the jurisdiction recognized in Article I of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the Three Affiliated Tribes and its members to provide for and regulate the quality of child day-care centers and similar programs for the children on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation, and
- whereas, The EVEN START Program is an entity which provides standard quality and safety as a child day-care center on the Reservation and is in need of an annual child day-care license in which to operate their program;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby grants a tribal day-care license to the EVEN START Program, such licensure to expire one year from date of approval by the Tribal Business Council.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That EVEN START shall be granted license number #93-DCC-01.
