- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Mandaree School District via its School Board has applied for, and has received approval for construction funding for the replacement of aging and dysfunctional water mains and service line; and
- WHEREAS, The Mandaree School District via its School Board has applied for, and received funding to do the engineering of this project, no engineering funds will be required our of the new highway construction funds for this project; and
- WHEREAS, This project would serve for the benefit of the membership of Fort Berthold in general and Mandaree Community and it's school children and staff in particular; and
- WHEREAS, This project would be cost effective, as a result of cost sharing of two different funding sources; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribes does agree to fund portion of the new construction of the street repairs requested by the Mandaree School Board from its highway trust funds, provided that the A&E costs are met be the Mandaree School Board, the design of the street repairs meet Federal Highway Standards and such costs are reasonable.
