applications from federally recognized Indian tribes for FY95 Indian

HOME Federal Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Berthold Housing Authority has indicated the Three Affiliated

Tribes has a need for an additional 582 new housing units according to

the IHA waiting list; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has administered the BIA Home Improvement Programs

and Tribal Rehabilitation Program to meet the needs of the tribal

residents; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has committeed a substantial amount of financial assistance

for tribal housing rehabilitation from a limited cash flow annually; and

WHEREAS, the FY95 HOME Assistance Program will greatly assist the

Three Affiliated Tribes in providing safe, decent and affordable

tribal housing on the Fort Berthold Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Indian HOME Assistance Program requires the Tribal

applicant to provide a 37.5% matching share of the total program

costs; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold

Reservation endorses the attached application federal financial assistance to the Department of Housing and Urban Development to establish an Indian HOME Assistance Program for tribal members and their
