RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reoprganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities in the interest and welfare of the Tribes and the enrolled members thereof; and
- whereas, Article VI, Section 5(c), provides that the Council may administer any funds or property within the exclusive control of the Tribes to make expenditures from available Tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, An action plan has been presented for the development of an Office for Tourism and Cultural Programming for the Three Affiliated Tribes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Tribal Business Council does hereby establish for a 120 day trial period a Tourism and Cultural Development Office;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That such office and its staff be subject to the operational and budgetary guidelines attached here-in, and that the Office shall be subject to the direction of a tribal Tourism and Cultural Development Board established by the Tribal Business Council.
