
RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and the benefit of the tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes granted a corporate charter to the Twin Buttes community by resolution dated 10, November 1983, which generally authorizes and empowers the Twin Buttes Community Association to engage in activities on behalf and in the interest of the welfare and benefits of the community and the members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Twin Buttes Community Association desires to lease, develop, operate and maintain two sites specifically; the first being the end of ND. # 8 highway site, and the second known as the pow wow rodeo grounds site east of Twin Buttes. (See attachments #1 and #2), and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council believes that such an area would provide much needed access to the waters of the Lake Sakakawea and provide opportunities to the Twin Buttes community and it's members.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the Chairmen to negotiate and/or enter into a lease with Twin Buttes Community Association to develop, operate, and maintain the aforementioned recreation sites.


TRACT MAP (WITH GRID) OF GROUP OR RECREATIONAL-EDUCATIONAL CAMP SITE
