### RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- The constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and WHEREAS. empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS. Article VI of the Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution empowers the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes to establish and operate a Tribal Court; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5(1) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes the Tribal Business Council to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure(s) of tribal agencies; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold District Court is in need of updating and adopting a Court Fee Schedule for the purposes of assessing costs incurred by the Court; and
- WHEREAS The Fort Berthold District Court presently shares the filing fees assessed for divorces and marriages with the Domestic Violence Program, to-wit:

20.00 remains	e (divorces) with the Court Domestic Violence
6.00 remains	e license fee with the Court Domestic Violence; and

- The Court has experienced a dramatic rise in its caseload thereby incurring WHEREAS. excessive Court costs for office supplies, which has been approximately \$20,000 for the past Fiscal Year; and
- The Court has been required to pay for its own office supplies, rental space WHEREAS. and utility costs out of its Fines and Costs Budget; whereas, these costs are normally paid out of the Indirect Cost Pool for other Tribal Programs; and
