- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefits of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof, and
- WHEREAS, The Tribe sought competitive bids on the completion of the Mandaree and White Shield Water Treatment Plants, and;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby awards the construction contract to Capital City Construction of Bismarck, North Dakota, and shall construct the facilities as follows:
 - Mandaree Treatment Plant not to exceed \$539,000,00
 - White Shield Treatment Plant not to exceed \$927,000.00
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes.
