RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS**, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Fort Berthold Indian Reservation has experienced a severe weather conditions the winter of 1996-197 and severe spring storm April 4, 1997; and
- **WHEREAS**, The state of North Dakota was declared a disaster by Governor Shafer and President Clinton; and
- **WHEREAS**, By proclamation the Chairman has declared the Fort Berthold Reservation within the state of North Dakota a disaster area; and
- **WHEREAS,** As a result of the severe weather numerous livestock died throughout the Reservation leaving carcases posing a health threat to the environment; and
- **WHEREAS**, The North Dakota National Guard will be disposing of the carcases without cost to the Three Affiliated Tribes with the assurance that all tribal environmental codes be met.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED.** That the Tribal Business Council hereby designates a carcase burial site on the west side of the Reservation legally described as Section 32, Range 149, Township 92 (South half).
- **BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER RESOLVED.** That a burial site in the South Segment is to be designated by Councilman Spotted Bear.
- **FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Three Affiliated Tribes officially expresses their appreciation to the North Dakota National Guard.
