## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities in the best interest and welfare of the Tribes and the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section C provides that the Council may administer any funds or property within the exclusive control of the Tribes to make expenditures from available Tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribes are in receipt of beneficial revenues generated from gaming activities authorized by federal law under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 USC sect. 2701, et seq.; and
- WHEREAS, It is important to support our community organizations who can and have provided beneficial and important cultural activities for our communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council does hereby grant to the Parshall-Luckymound Community an additional \$2000.00 dollars for the purpose of assisting the 1997 annual Nux Baaga Celebration.
