- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; an
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and the benefit of the tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribes are in receipt of beneficial revenues generated from gaming activities authorized by federal law under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act. 25 U.S.C. 2701, et. seq; and,
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes encourage and support strongly traditional activities of our native culture on the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The five (5) Pow-wow committees, Twin Buttes, White Shield, Mandaree, Parshall and Four Bears, of the Fort Berthold Reservation, have conducted a Pow-wow every summer, emulating our traditional heritage from time immemorial; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribes Council approves a \$15,000.00 grant per committee for the purpose of the 1998 Segment Celebrations.
