- WHEREAS, the Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution and by-laws empowers the tribal council with the authority to represent the tribes and to negotiate with the federal, State and local governments and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Charter, issued in 1974, is the authority under which the Fort Berthold Community College plans, develops, and implement post-secondary training for the reservation community and
- WHEREAS, the aforementioned tribal charter grants authority to the Fort Berthold Community College to develop and operate programs for the advancement of education at the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the tribes have requested the Fort Berthold Community College develop and administer vocational training services and programs to the area public under instructional services offered and
- WHEREAS, the tribe is eligible for Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Applied Technology Education, known as Indian Vocational Education Program grant funds under the Indian Self Determination And Education Assistance Act of April 16, 1934

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribes hereby directs the Fort Berthold Community College to apply for and administer any and all projects which may be funded under this act (CFDA 84.101).
