

Resolution of the governing body of
the Three Affiliated Tribes of the
Fort Berthold Reservation

- WHEREAS This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS The Constitution of The Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities in the best interest and welfare of the Tribes and the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS Article VI, Section (C) , provides that the Council may administer any funds or property within the exclusive control of the Tribes to make expenditures from available Tribal Funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS Rural North Dakota has a high instance of poverty, especially concerning women and girls; and
- WHEREAS, The Northwest North Dakota Girl Scout Council has the responsibility to reach all girls of all socio economic groups and all ethnic backgrounds and have placed 1 VISTA volunteer and are recruiting 2 more VISTA volunteers on the Fort Berthold Reservation. Serving the communities within NW North Dakota of White Shield, Parshall, New Town, and Mandaree; and
- WHEREAS, The objective of the VISTA positions and grant funds is to enable the NW North Dakota Girl Scout Council to reach girls who were not being served due to economic reasons, lack of volunteer leadership or lack of opportunity; and
- WHEREAS, Support and sponsorship will have a positive impact on the lives of our young Native American girls who participate in the Girl Scout Movement through positive role modeling;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council does hereby grant to the Northwest North Dakota Girl Scout Council Inc. Five-thousand dollars, \$5,000 for the purpose of sponsorship and support for VISTA members and Northwest ND Girl Scout Council members to increase community service and improve the quality of life for our children.
