RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5(c) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to administer the funds within the exclusive control of the Tribes and to make expenditures from available Tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council believes that it would be in the best interests of the Tribes to create and fill an administrator/director position within the Tribal government structure to oversee the administration of the current SPCC-OPA, CERCLA, and SARA Title III grants of the Tribes, in addition to the prospective hazardous materials planning core grant; and
- WHEREAS, The title of the proposed position would be the Emergency Management Director; and
- WHEREAS, Martina McKinney has served in the capacity of Oil and Gas Specialist for a period in excess of three (3) years within the Environmental Division of the Tribal government, and has developed substantial familiarity with the SPCC-OPA, CERCLA, and SARA Title III grants and with the application for the prospective hazardous materials planning core grant; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has determined that Martina McKinney would be well qualified to fill the proposed position of Emergency Management Director on at least a temporary basis pending advertisement of and ultimate selection for the position;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby creates the position of Emergency Management Director and hereby appoints Martina McKinney to fill this position on a temporary basis pending advertisement of and ultimate selection for the position on a permanent basis.
