- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes, with the Fort Berthold Community College as contractor, will request funding to continue the provision of basic library services; improve the level of professional proficiency; and, advance the Ft. Berthold Library's operation to new levels of service on the Fort Berthold Reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the contracting of Fiscal Year 1999 funding received through the Institute of Museums and Library Services, Native American Library Services to the Fort Berthold Community College for purposes outlined above.
