- **WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- **WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Pow-Wow is a cultural event the occurs in all segments of the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has supplemented the cost of the Pow Wow's in the past,
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council must put a cap on funding Pow-Wows, and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council realizes that fund raising is difficult,
- **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** The Pow Committee's will be capped at \$15,000.00 for Parshall, Mandaree, Four Bears, White Shield and Twin Buttes. Twin Buttes will receive an additional \$3,000.00 for money they did not receive in 1998.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** As an incentive for fund raising these Pow Wow Committee's will receive matching funds up to the amount of \$5,000.00 for funds raised.
