RESOLUTION OF THE BOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS**, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18,1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled member thereof; and
- WHEREAS, It is the intention of Tribal, State, and Federal Programs to enhance, ensure, and oversee activities directly relating to programs and activities for the tribal members of the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
- **WHEREAS:** It is with the understanding that the New Town Ambulance Service together with the reservation will coordinate to promote standard emergency medical services for the members of the reservation; and
- **WHEREAS:** The Three Affiliated Tribes will provide educational benefits and mileage to and from the reservation. With the mileage not to exceed \$500.00.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribal Council and the Fort Berthold reservation will provide the benefits as designated in the EMS proposal. All benefits will be provided to a team of Emergency Medical Technicians who will be volunteering their services in conjunction with the afore mentioned benefits; and
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** In order to secure appropriate emergency medical service's for the tribal members of the reservation the Emergency Technicians will join with the New Town Ambulance Service; and
- FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribal Emergency Medical volunteers and the members of the New Town Ambulance Service will act as a professional team to enhance, oversee, and promote quality emergency medical services for the tribal members of the Fort Berthold Reservation.
