**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

**WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the enrolled members; and

**WHEREAS,** The Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes empowers the Tribal Business Council to revise the membership rolls and to govern future membership rolls; and

**WHEREAS,** CURTIS OLSON JR., 301U-10127 has requested relinquishment of his/her membership from the Three Affiliated Tribes.

**WHEREAS,** CURTIS OLSON JR., is eligible for enrollment with the Menominee Tribe of Wisconsin and has applied for membership.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that CURTIS OLSON JR., is hereby relinquished from the official membership roll of the Three Affiliated Tribes.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Menominee Indian Tribe is to be advised of this action by a copy of this approved Resolution.

**C E R T I F I C A T I O N**

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of 7 members of whom 5 constitute a quorum, 7 were present at a Regular meeting thereof duly called, noticed, convened, and held on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1999; that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of 5 members, 2 members opposed, 0 members abstained, and 0 members not voting and that said Resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
