Kenneth Hall, pursuant to the Tribal Constitution and the Election Ordinance of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Mandan, Hidatsa, Arikara Nation hereby gives notice to the eligible voters of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the following elections:

Secretary will begin receiving Applications for Candidacy on Wednesday July 27, 2016. In order to be eligible to become a candidate for any of the above offices you must file a Notice of Candidacy together with a non-refundable filing fee of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) with the Secretary of the Tribal Business Council by no later than 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, August 11, 2016.

Qualifications for candidacy to the Tribal Business Council are as set forth in the Tribal Constitution and Election Ordinance, which, can be obtained from the Secretary's Office. In order to be eligible to vote in the Primary Election you must be 18 years of age or older on September 20, 2016. In order to be eligible to vote in the general elections you must be 18 years of age or older on November, 8, 2016.
