

# ROAD TO NABI GAME RULES

## Pool & Bracket Halves

- 20 Minutes/running clock. Clock stops at dead ball in the last 2minutes of the game.

## Champion Halves

- 16 Minute/stop time.

## Half-time

- 5 minutes
- \*15 minutes during the “Championship Games”.

## Time-Outs

- Each team has two 30 second time-outs and two full time-outs for the entire regulation game. They can all be used in the second half. Time-outs do not carry over into overtime.

## Overtime time-outs

- Each team has one full time out and one 30 second time-out in any overtime. The other timeouts do not carry over into overtime.
- A full time-out is 1 minute.

## Advancement to Championship Bracket

- Two teams with the best records from each pool will advance to the Single Elimination Bracket Games
- In the case of a tie, it will be based on average total points given up on games played in the pool.

## Uniform Policy

- ALL Players/Coaches must provide their own uniforms.

## Bench

- Only team and coaches are allowed to sit on team bench.

## NO Shows or Tardy

- Teams and/or head coach who arrive 10 minutes after their *listed* game start time, will forfeit their game.
- Players must report on time to their first schedule game to play in the tournament.
- If any player is late, after their first scheduled game, they must sit out the first half. Player will not be allowed to play if they arrive after the first half.

## Player Eligibility Challenges

- Only team head coaches can call a challenge (checking of opposing team players age, HS grade and/or tribal member status). All challenges must be brought to the attention of R2N staff or official 10 minutes prior to the start of the game. All coaches must carry in their possession their player’s proof of age, High School grade and proof of Native blood (CIB or Enrollment ID). If a challenged is posed and coach cannot prove eligibility, the player will be disqualified from the tournament. In the case of more than one players cannot prove eligibility, the entire team will be disqualified from tournament and suspended from competing in the NABI tournament for 1 year.

\* Half-times may exceed 15 minutes during Championship Games due to special events happening during the half-time.

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
