

# ICE FISHING RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Ice Fishing tournament is scheduled for Monday, February 26th, from 8:00am until 2:00 p.m. on Lake Sakakawea.
2. Registration will be from 8:00am to 10:00am of February 26, 2018 at the Four Bears Marina
3. All fish entered must be brought to the weigh-in station immediately and be alive. Please bring a bag or bucket, as the tournament is live release. Dead or frozen fish are ineligible. Judges shall have the right to verify that fish were legally caught. The decision of the judge is final. Contestants are responsible for verification of weight of fish at time of weigh in.
4. There is no entry fee for the tournament.
5. There will be no boundaries for the fishing tournament
6. All laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes & State of North Dakota will be abided by.  
All contestants MUST have a valid North Dakota Fishing License and observe all fishing rules and regulations.
7. Parking on the ice is at YOUR OWN RISK.
8. All bait fish must be six inches or smaller. Any bait fish over six inches will not be allowed on the ice.
9. Failure to comply with any contest rules subject's contestants to disqualification and removal from competition site, as determined by contest officials.
10. All prizes for each category will be determined by weight & all decisions are final.
11. The Four Bear Casino & Lodge & MHA Nation is not responsible for any accidents.
12. Tribal Participants 16 years or older must possess either tribal fishing license or ND State fishing license.
13. All current Three Affiliated Tribes Fish & Wildlife and North Dakota Game & Fish regulations must be followed.
