Noted issues with water on the pads working with the compliance Officer to test the site. The change in fees at \$500 application fee to cover Dept. cost. \$1000 payment for any item under 1 acre. Discussion: Tom Wells discussed possible problems with their system accepting amounts other that what was approved for tribal tracts for undivided interests. One of the operators asked if Compliance Officers need to test well pad water discharge from rain events and if need the Tribe has the manpower to test all the wells pads on the trust and allottee lands. Operator suggested on trust land industry provide the test results to the tribe. Travis Hallam noted that regulatory extends to anywhere within the exterior boundaries.

Ice house removal date added and stipulations for the use of drones, use of water craft for hunting access and discussion of the return of excess lands and the new jurisdictional responsibilities. No pronghorn season this year.

The Indian contractors expressed concern over their inability to provide input to the new regulations. Deadline date with the three readings looks to be in August.

C. Update- Fee to Trust Buffalo Ranch- BIA – Tom Wells, BIA

Regional Director requested for the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs. in DC to bring ranch into trust and can't issue due to the environmental liability being over \$500,000 and a future policy of land into trust running through the Central Office. Recommended lobbying with the acting Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs to address this. Farm pasture bid sale on all tribal tracts and issues with undivided interests.

Motion: Councilman Fred Fox moved to rescind the motion of Farm Pasture biding of all tribal tracts and forward approval of the bid sale to the April Tribal Business Council. Councilman Frank Grady seconded the motion. Vote: 3-0-0. Motion carried.
